Sutivan

The history of the former fishing village dates back to Roman times, and some buildings there were built in the era of the Emperor Diocletian. Only ruins remain of the former byzantine basilica from the 6th century. Next to it is the church of St. John the Baptist (Sveti Ivan) from the 16th century, which is one of the most important attractions of Sutivan.

Things to do:

- Visit Parish Church of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary,
- Visit the church of St. John the Baptist (Sveti Ivan),
- See the summer House Of Jerolim Kavanjin (a famous poet from Split)

Shipwreck

The sunken boat Kontesa in Nečujam bay on the island of Šolta is the perfect place for children and adults to enjoy snorkeling. Resting at a depth of just 1 meter below the surface, this boat provides an ideal opportunity to spend some quality time exploring the underwater world.
